In 1944 bandleaders Duke Ellington and Harry James collaborated with alto saxophonist Johnny Hodge222s to develop his melody into the hit song "I'm Beginning to See the Light" with a lyric by Don George, The song I'M BEGINNING TO SEE THE LIGHT spent several weeks on Your Hit Parade and I'M BEGINNING TO SEE THE LIGHT charted three times in 1945 with James' version leading the pack. Vocalist Joya Sherrill, who was only seventeen, had just joined the Ellington band when they recorded this tune
