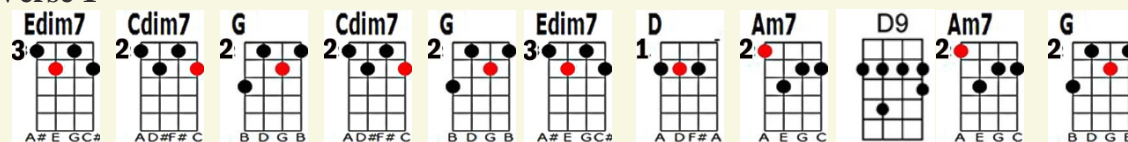

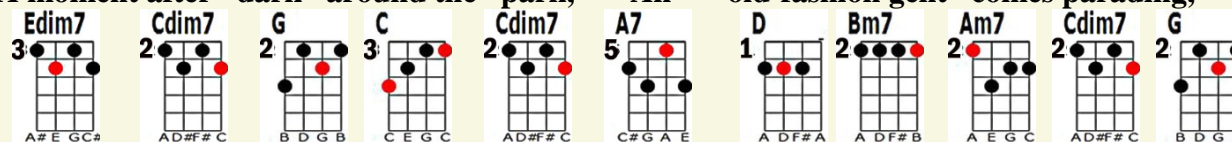

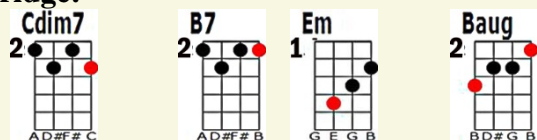


A moment after dark around the park, An old-fashion gent comes parading,

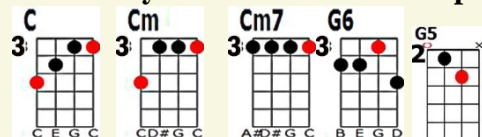


Dressed in funny clothes but singing as he goes, The Lamplighter's Ser - e - nade

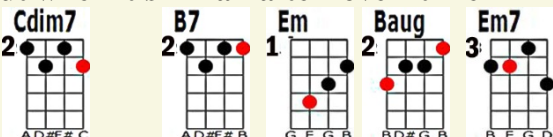

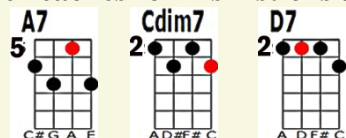
The old boy loves to talk with couples on the walk,
