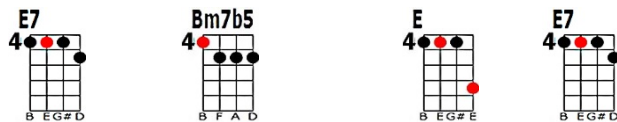

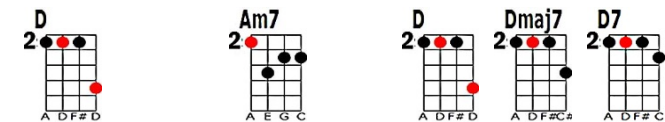

The lazy, lazy river in the noon-day sun,



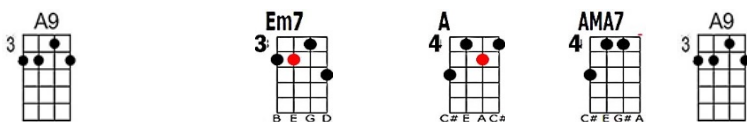
Linger in the shade of a kind old tree,



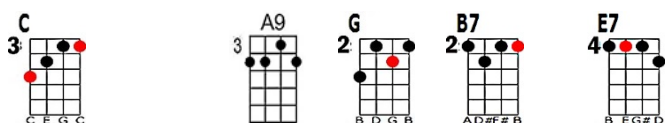
Throw away your troubles, dream a dream with me.



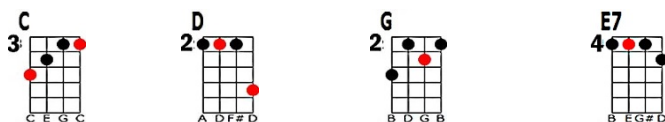
Up the lazy river, where the robin's song



Awaits a brand new mornin' as we just roll a-long.

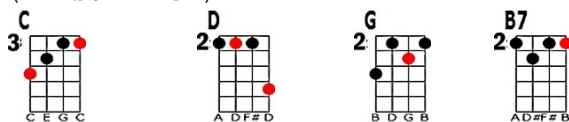


Blue skies up above, ev'-ry-one's in love,
