


348 Father of the jazz violin, Joe Venuti, introduced "Moonglow" on a recording date for the American Record Company's Banner label in September, 1933. The composer Will Hudson, tells that the composition happened very simply. "Back in the early '30s, I had **MOONGLOW** a band at the Graystone Ballroom in Detroit, and I needed a theme song. So I wrote 'Moonglow.'" The song's appeal never really dwindled. With a clever counter-melody composed by George Dunning and new words by Steve Allen, **WORDS AND MUSIC BY WILL HUDSON,** the tune was an integral part of the 1955 motion picture **EDDIE DE LANGE AND IRVING MILLS**
