The ro - ses are sigh -ing a moonlight ser - e - nade.

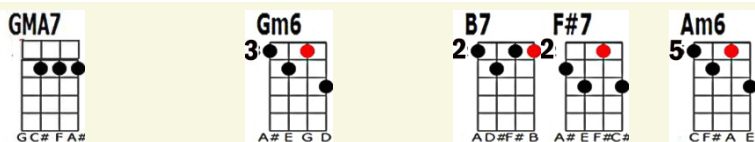
Verse 2

The stars are aglow, And tonight how their light sets me dream-ing.

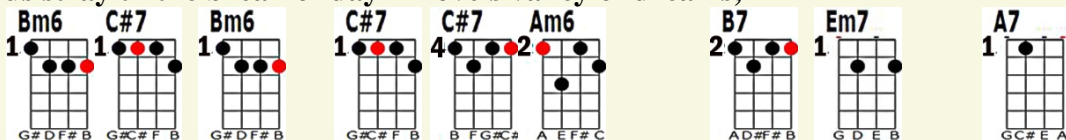
My love, do you know That your eyes are like stars brightly beaming

Bridge:

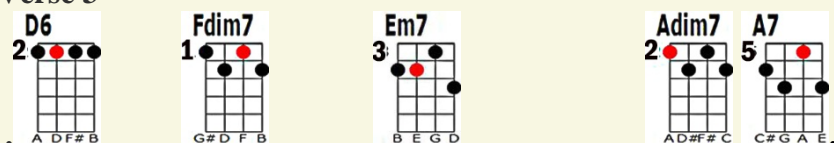


Let us stray til the break of day In love's valley of dreams,



Just you and I, a sum - mer sky, A hea - ven - ly breeze kiss - ing the trees

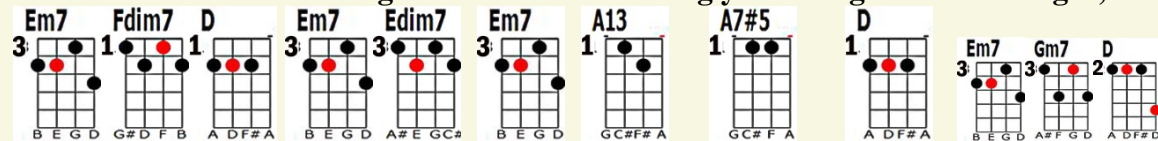
