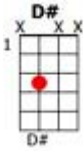


Composer Victor Young and lyricist Edward Heyman wrote "When I Fall in Love" for the 1952 film One Minute to Zero. Although the lyric did not appear in the film, a phrase from the lyric refers to the unsettled nature of the time: In restless world like this, Love is ended before it's begun." The movie, a Korean War drama, was overlaid by a romance between Robert Mitchum and Ann Blythe
